Dear Property Owner,

Please participate in the 2017 **RSF Connect 1-Gigabit Community Advisory Vote**. Your vote is needed to:

- Approve the RSF Connect 1-Gigabit high-speed internet project
- Indicate your interest in the services to be offered

The enclosed ballot must be received at the pre-addressed post office box of the Inspector of Elections or deposited into the locked ballot box at the RSF Association office by **5:00 pm on Wednesday, October 4, 2017**, to be counted.

The Board of Directors is recommending approval of the RSF Connect 1-Gigabit project as described in the enclosed Voter's Guide. A YES vote will indicate that you approve the project. A NO vote will indicate that you do not approve it. A majority of the votes cast will determine the outcome.

Included in this ballot package is a blue survey card to ascertain your interest in the service offerings. The survey will provide an indication of how many homeowners will sign up for the internet service, TV service, telephone service or a combination. By returning the card, you are indicating your interest, **but are not obligating yourself**. The information will enable the internet service provider selected by the Association to contact you regarding setting up service to your home.

Ballot Instructions:

1. Vote YES or NO on approval of the RSF Connect 1-Gigabit project on the green ballot. Place an "X" next to YES to indicate that you approve the project. Place an "X" next to NO to indicate that you do not approve it.
2. Complete the blue indication of interest survey, which will register your priorities for the RSF Connect project and your likelihood to subscribe to the service.
3. Place the green ballot and the blue survey in the yellow return envelope.
4. On the upper left hand corner of the return envelope please write your physical street address in the Covenant. Please sign your name, indicating that your printed name, mailing address, parcel identifier and physical street address on the envelope are correct. Your signature will be verified against your signature on file. If we do not have your signature on file, your physical street address will be used to validate your ballot.

All property owners are asked to vote. The fiber-optic network is a significant Association investment that will bring 1-Gigabit internet speed to all properties in the Covenant.
