# Statistics 2021

- Handled 3,576 calls for service, a 12% decrease from 2020
- Alarm calls are approximately 6% of all calls.
- Most crimes are “opportunistic” in nature.
- We had 16 burglaries, 11 being residential and 5 commercial, meaning they occurred in a business or construction site.
- Grand Thefts stayed the same.
- 18% of calls are self initiated by the Patrol Officers.

# Traffic Collisions

- There were 22 injury collisions (16 in 2020)
- There were 79 non injury collisions (62 in 2020)
- This is an increase from 2020 (due to COVID) and about the same number of collisions from 2019.
- From our observations, the predominant factor in all collisions was excessive speed (41), second was right of way violations (22) third was inattention (12).

# Summary

- Average response time for all calls was 6:00 minutes.
- Slight increase in residential burglaries for 2021. We had several burglaries believed committed by the same person(s).
- Quick response by Patrol netted one Burglary arrest. That person maybe responsible for other burglaries in the area.
- 18% of the calls logged were field observations generated by our patrol officers.
- Calls for service decreased by 429 calls.
- 1,080 calls were assistance calls for the Sheriff, CHP and the Fire Department.
- We drove over 116,000 miles and conducted over 24,000 security checks.
